Obtain a 2 liter (64 fl. Oz.) plastic soft drink container

Drill a hole through the top cap and attach a heavy string, twine or wire

Hang securely in a sunny location about 5 feet off the ground. Trap may be hung from a tree or other suitable structure, away from kids and pets.

Drill three ½" holes approximately half way up the container.

Mix water and apple juice concentrate (not pre mix juice) at a 50/50 ratio and fill to depth of 3-5 inches.

Hang when weather begins to warm (April or May) . Although there won't be a lot of yellow jacket activity, this is when the queens emerge from hibernation and begin looking for nest sites.
